

Expired Wolverhampton UDP Policies following adoption of Area Action Plans

The list below shows which policies, supporting paragraphs and proposals of the adopted Wolverhampton Unitary Development Plan (UDP 2006) have been replaced upon the adoption of the Stafford Road Corridor Area Action Plan (adopted 17th September 2014) and the Bilston Corridor Area Action Plan (adopted 17th September 2014).

UDP Policies replaced by the Stafford Road Corridor Area Action Plan

The Policies Map illustrates the geographical extent of policies within the Local Plan. For the Stafford Road Corridor Area Action Plan area; all UDP Proposal Map designations, as amended by the Black Country Core Strategy, will be replaced by the AAP designations save for:

- EP7 Protection of Floodplains
- AM4 Strategic Highway Network
- AM5 Highway Improvement Line
- R6 Greenways/Canal Network

For clarity, Green Belt boundaries have not been reviewed through the AAP and remain unchanged.

- Flood Zone 3 / Flood Zone 2 (EP7)
- Strategic Highway Network (AM4)
- Highway Improvement Lines (AM5)
