**Wolverhampton City Centre Covid 19 response emergency highway measures**

You will be aware that the City of Wolverhampton Council is making significant changes to the highway within the City centre in order to prioritise public safety and maintain social distancing as part of its response to Covid 19.

This has necessitated the temporary redesigning of some of our public spaces to create more space for walking and cycling and for the safe operation of buses around the city. Some roads have been made one way and some have been closed to traffic. As a consequence, servicing and access arrangements for your premises may well have changed.

Servicing for Lichfield Street (west), Darlington Street, Victoria Street, Queen Square, Dudley Street, Queen Street (west), King Street, Bilston Street and Exchange Street will be limited to hours outside 8.30 am to 4.00 pm Monday to Sunday. These new arrangements will be under constant monitoring and may be reviewed as necessary.
