THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (1 CLARENDON STREET) COMPULSORY PURCHASE ORDER 2019

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Wolverhampton City Council has made the Wolverhampton City Council (1 Clarendon Street) Compulsory Purchase Order 2019 under the Housing Act 1985 and the Acquisition of Land Act 1981. It is about to submit this order to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government for confirmation, and if confirmed the order will authorise Wolverhampton City Council to purchase compulsorily the land described below for the purpose of the provision of housing accommodation.

A copy of the order and of the accompanying map may be seen at all reasonable hours at Main Reception, Civic Centre, St Peter's Square, Wolverhampton WV1 1RG.

Any objection to the order must be made in writing to the Secretary of State for Communities and Local Government, National Planning Casework Unit, 5 St Philip's Place, Colmore Row, Birmingham B3 2PW before 28 January 2021 and should state the title of the order, the grounds of objection and the objector's address and interests in the land.
