**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984, SECTION 14(1)**

**WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (COMMONWEALTH GAMES)**  
**(WEST PARK ROAD RACE)**  
**(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2022**

Wolverhampton City Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and by the Birmingham Commonwealth Games Act 2020, section 26(1) to (5) and any other enabling powers hereby make the following Order:

**SECTION 1 – PRELIMINARY**

**Citation and Commencement**

1. The order shall come into operation on the 3<sup>rd</sup> day of August 2022 and remain in force until the 5<sup>th</sup> day of August 2022 and may be cited as The Wolverhampton City Council (Commonwealth Games) (West Park Road Race) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2022.
2. The order is made to facilitate transport services and travel by persons in connection with the Commonwealth Games and to reduce disruption to traffic likely to be caused by the Games.

**Interpretation**

3. In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them: -

“2022 Order” means The Civil Enforcement of Road Traffic Contraventions (Approved Devices Charging Guidelines and General Provisions) (England) Regulations 2022;

“Accredited Person” means a person who has been granted a range of police powers by the chief constable of police under the Community safety accreditation schemes (CSAS) created under section 40 of the Police Reform Act 2002;

“Authorised Person” means an employee or agent of the Council, the Executive, Organising Committee authorised to exercise all or any of the functions under this order;

“Authorised Vehicle” means a Vehicle being used in connection with the operation of or providing official transport services for the Games and which is clearly identified as an official Commonwealth Games vehicle.

“Bus” has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016 (as amended);

“Civil Enforcement Officer” means an individual employed by the Council (or by an agent appointed to act on the Council’s behalf) in accordance with section 76 of the Traffic Management Act 2004 to enforce road traffic contraventions;

“Delivering” and “Collecting” in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

“Disabled Person’s Badge” has the same meaning as in The Local Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000.

“Disabled Person’s Vehicle” has the same meaning as in The Motor Vehicles (Approval) (Amendment) Regulations 2004;

“Dispensation Certificate” means a LAPP or VAPP issued by or on behalf of the Council or Organising Committee for the purpose of exempting a specified vehicle from driving, stopping, waiting or loading in specified circumstances on a length or lengths of road where the driving, stopping, waiting or loading of that vehicle would otherwise be restricted or prohibited;

“Enforcement Authority” means Wolverhampton City Council;

“Event” means an event forming part of the Games (whether or not a sporting event) or any other event arranged by, or on behalf of, the Organising Committee;

“Executive” known as Transport for West Midlands;

“Games” means the Birmingham Commonwealth Games 2022;

“Goods” means heavy or bulky goods or burden of any description and includes postal packages;

“Hackney Carriage” means a vehicle licensed and being lawfully used as a hackney carriage under the provisions of the Town Police Clauses Act 1847 and the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

“Healthcare Worker” means:

- a. any such persons currently identified by an NHS Trust (or any other name that it may subsequently be known) as being a general practitioner, doctor, registered nurse or any other nominated medical persons undertaking domiciliary visits to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from Roads within this Order or whose place of employment is accessible by vehicle only from Roads within this Order;
- b. any such persons as are authorised by the Council to be essential healthcare or family support visitors to patients residing within premises accessible by vehicle only from Roads within this Order;

“Loading” means the loading or unloading of goods to or from a vehicle;

"Loading Vehicle" means a vehicle being used for the purpose of loading and unloading of goods;

"Local Access Parking Permit" (LAPP) means a dispensation certificate issued by or on behalf of the Council and used in accordance with the terms and conditions;

"Motor Car", "Motorcycle" and "Motor Vehicle" has the same meanings as in Section 136 of the 1984 Act;

"Organising Committee" is the organising committee formed as the private company limited by guarantee registered as "Birmingham Organising Committee for the 2022 Commonwealth Games Ltd";

"Passenger Vehicle" means a motor vehicle (other than a motor cycle) constructed solely for the carriage of passengers and their effects and adapted to carry not more than twelve passengers exclusive of the driver and not drawing a trailer;

"Pedal Cycle" has the same meaning as in Schedule 1 of the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Penalty Charge" means the charges set by the enforcement authority in accordance with the 2022 Order which are to be paid not later than the last day of the period of 28 days beginning with the date on which the penalty charge notice was served;

"Penalty Charge Notice" means a notice served by a civil enforcement officer or by (or on behalf of) the enforcement authority in accordance with the 2022 Act.

"Permit" means a dispensation certificate;

"Permit Holder" means a person to whom a Permit has been issued under the provisions of this Order;

"Police Vehicle" has the same meaning as in the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016;

"Private Hire Vehicle" means a vehicle licensed under section 48 of the Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1976;

"Relevant Position" in respect of:

- a. a disabled person's badge and parking disc has the same meaning as the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000, and for the said length of Road unless otherwise;
- b. a dispensation certificate means exhibited behind the windscreen, on the dashboard or fascia of the vehicle or, where the vehicle does not have a windscreen, dashboard or fascia, in a conspicuous position on the vehicle so that the whole information on the front of the certificate is clearly legible from outside the vehicle;

“Reduced Penalty Charge” means the charges set by the enforcement authority in accordance with the 2022 Order which are to be paid not later than the last day of the period of 14 days beginning with the date on which the penalty charge notice was served;

“Road” has the same meaning as Section 142 (1) of the 1984 Act;

“Statutory Undertaker” has the meaning ascribed to ‘undertaker’ by section 48(4) of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991;

“Taxi” has the same meaning in this Order as Hackney Carriage;

“Traffic Sign” means a sign of any size, colour and type prescribed or authorised under, or having effect as though prescribed or authorised under, section 64 of the 1984 Act;

“Universal Service Provider” has the same meaning given by Section 65(1) of the Postal Services Act 2011;

“Vehicle” means either:

- a. a Motor Vehicle; or
- b. a Pedal Cycle in actual use for the purpose of cycling unless being used specifically for the purpose of the Birmingham 2022 Commonwealth Games Time Trial Event.

“Vehicle Access Parking Permit” (VAPP) means a dispensation certificate which has been issued by or on behalf of the Organising Committee and used in accordance with the terms and conditions.

4. Except where otherwise stated, any reference in this Order to a numbered Article or Schedule is a reference to the Article or Schedule bearing that number in this Order.

### **Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting**

5. Save as provided within Articles 6 and 7 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, cause or permit any vehicle to wait or load in the lengths of road during the periods described in Schedule 1 to this Order.
6. Nothing in Article 5 shall apply to:
  - a. The driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers;
  - b. any vehicle being used on the direction of or with the permission of an authorised person, a traffic marshal, accredited person or other official, authorised in the control and operation of the event or in accordance with traffic management traffic signs;

- c. any motor vehicle which is being used by the police, ambulance service or fire brigade in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties where the restriction would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle in fulfilling that purpose, and which is taking all reasonable precautions;
  - d. any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid dispensation certificate being used in accordance with the terms and conditions.
7. Nothing in Article 5 render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to wait in any of the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary:
- a. to enable a person to board or alight from the vehicle;
  - b. whilst the driver is actively loading goods on to or unloading goods from the vehicle (except on those lengths of road identified in the schedule as “no loading” during the period identified);
  - c. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
    - i. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
    - ii. which is being used by a statutory undertaker in an emergency such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water in the area which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into the lengths of road;
    - iii. which is being used by a local authority officer or their contactors for emergency works such as for road or street lighting repairs;
  - d. any vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
    - i. official vehicle being used in connection with the event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes;
    - ii. any official vehicle associated with the Games including local authority vehicles.
  - e. any vehicle of a doctor, healthcare worker or meal delivery driver visiting clients;
  - f. any hackney carriage/taxi/ or private hire vehicle needing to pick up or drop off clients within a closed road which are not associated with the event;
  - g. any vehicle, so long as access by these vehicles is reasonably necessary in connection with any wedding or funeral;

- h. to enable the vehicle if it bears the livery of a Universal Service Provider being used for the purposes of the provision of a universal postal service as defined in the Postal Services Act 2000.

### **Prohibition of Stopping**

- 8. Save as provided in Article 10 and 11 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, or when the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop or is obliged to stop to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside of his control, cause or permit a vehicle to stop in the lengths of road during the periods described in Schedule 2 of this Order.
- 9. Save as provided in Article 13 and 14 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or a civil enforcement officer, or when the person in control of the vehicle is required by law to stop or is obliged to stop to avoid an accident or is prevented from proceeding by circumstances outside of his control, cause or permit a vehicle other than a Bus to stop in the lengths of road during the periods described in Schedule 3 of this Order.
- 10. Nothing in Articles 8 and 9 shall apply to:
  - a. the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers;
  - b. any vehicle being used on the direction of or with the permission of an authorised person, a traffic marshal, accredited person or other official, authorised in the control and operation of the event or in accordance with traffic management traffic signs;
  - c. any motor vehicle which is being used by the police, ambulance service or fire brigade in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties where the restriction would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle in fulfilling that purpose, and which is taking all reasonable precaution;
  - d. any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid dispensation certificate being used in accordance with the terms and conditions.
- 11. Nothing in Articles 8 and 9 render it unlawful to cause or permit a vehicle to stop in any of the lengths of road specified therein for so long as may be necessary:
  - a. to enable the vehicle, if it cannot be conveniently be used for such purpose in any other road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
    - i. the removal of any obstruction to traffic;

- ii. which is being used by a statutory undertaker in an emergency such as the loss of supplies of gas, electricity or water in the area which necessitates the bringing of vehicles into the lengths of road;
  - iii. which is being used by a local authority officer or their contactors for emergency works such as for road or street lighting repairs;
- b. any vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
  - i. official vehicle being used in connection with the event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes;
  - ii. any official vehicle associated with the Games including local authority vehicles.

### **Prohibited and Prescribed Movements**

- 12. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or accredited person or authorised person cause any vehicle to enter at any time, along the lengths of road and through the junction described in Schedule 4 of this Order.
- 13. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or accredited person or authorised person shall cause any vehicle to proceed, along the roads or lengths of road described in Schedule 5 of this Order.
- 14. Save as provided in Articles 15 and 16 no person shall, except in the case of an emergency upon the direction or permission of a police constable in uniform or accredited person or authorised person cause any vehicle to proceed other than in the direction specified, at any time, along the lengths of road described in Schedule 6 of this Order.
- 15. Nothing in Articles 12, 13 and 14 shall apply to:
  - a. anything done with the permission of or at the direction of a police officer in uniform;
  - b. the driving of any mechanical road cleansing vehicle being used in pursuance of statutory powers;
  - c. any motor vehicle which is being used by the police, ambulance service or fire brigade in pursuance of their statutory powers and duties where the restriction would be likely to hinder the use of that vehicle in fulfilling that purpose, and which is taking all reasonable precautions.
  - d. any vehicle being used on the direction of or with the permission of an authorised person, accredited person or other official, authorised in the

control and operation of the event or in accordance with traffic management traffic signs;

- e. any vehicle if it cannot conveniently be used for such purpose in any other length of road, to be used in connection with any of the following operations:
  - i. official vehicle being used in connection with the event including those used for stewarding, crowd management and traffic management purposes;
  - ii. any authorised vehicle.

- 16. The provisions of Articles 12, 13 and 14 shall not apply to any vehicle displaying in the relevant position a valid dispensation certificate being used in accordance with the terms and conditions.
- 17. The provisions of this order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs, as authorised by Section 64 of the 1984 Act.
- 18. The provisions of this order are only valid for so long as the relevant traffic signs and notices are erected on street or until the 13th August 2022, whichever is the earliest.
