# City centre improvements – Lichfield Street and Queen Square


High streets across the UK have suffered from reduced footfall and the closure of shops and businesses as a result of the pandemic and economic downturn over the past couple of years. We've already taken steps to begin reshaping our city centre to make it a place that attracts people for not only shopping but also for events and activities in its public spaces.

Work on the first two phases of the city centre public realm improvement programme in the Victoria Street and Civic Halls areas are well underway and we are now preparing to move to the next phase.
