

Declaration for the companion of a voter with disabilities

Election of councillors to:

A voter with disabilities is a voter who has made a declaration that he or she is so incapacitated by his or her blindness or other disability, or by his or her inability to read, as to be unable to vote without assistance. In this form, "voter" means the person casting the vote at the election and includes a person voting as a proxy.
