## THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (FOOT PATH 382 AND FOOTPATH 383 CHILWORTH AVENUE TO TWYFORD GROVE TO WYMERING AVENUE) GATING ORDER 2008

This Order is made by Wolverhampton City Council ("the Council") under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Council that the footpaths are affected by crime and anti-social behaviour by the existence of the lengths of footpaths described below are facilitating the persistent commission of crime and it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purpose of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour.

## BY THIS ORDER:

- The public rights of way over the footpaths shown on the plan attached ("the plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order ("the footpaths") will be restricted at all times by the erection of gates across the footpaths at the locations marked on the plan ("the gates").
- Access to the footpaths will be permitted by the provision of keys to highway
  maintenance contractors employed by Wolverhampton City Council,
  Emergency Services and public utility companies.
- The maintenance of the gates will be the responsibility of the Highways
   Division of the Council at Heantun House, Salop Street, Wolverhampton with
   Mr Gwyn James being the point of contact on telephone number 01902

## SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER THE FOOTPATHS

The length of Footpath 382 running from a point 7 metres south of its junction with Wymering Avenue at Point A to its junction with Footpath 383, a length of approximately 18 metres. The length of Footpath 383 running from a point 5 metres west of its junction with Twyford Grove at Point B to its junction with Chilworth Avenue at Point C, a length of approximately 92 metres.
