This Order is made by Wolverhampton City Council ("the Council") under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Council that the footpath is affected by crime and anti-social behaviour by the existence of the length of footpath described below is facilitating the persistent commission of crime and it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purpose of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour.

BY THIS ORDER:

- The public right of way over the footpath shown on the plan attached ("the plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order ("the footpath") will be restricted at all times by the erection of gates across the footpath at the location marked on the plan ("the gates").
- Access to the footpath will be permitted by the provision of keys to highway
 maintenance contractors employed by Wolverhampton City Council,
 emergency services and public utility companies.

SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER THE FOOTPATH

The length of Footpath 284 running from its junction with Rooker Crescent at Point A to the point at which it enters the disused garage site at Point B, a length of approximately 69 metres.
