## BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the highway shown on the plan attached ("the plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order ("the highway") will be restricted during the hours of 7.00pm to 8.00am by the erection of vehicular and pedestrian gates across the highway at the location marked on the plan ("the gates").
- Access to the highway will be permitted by the provision of keys to the occupiers of Princess Alley and the Emergency Services.
- The maintenance of the gates will be the responsibility of the Highways Division of the Council at Heantun House, Salop Street, Wolverhampton with Mr Bob Willis being the point of contact on telephone number 01902 555790.
- The distribution of the keys will be the responsibility of South West
   Neighbourhood Safety Coordinator, Mr Jim Smith on telephone number 01902
   572471.

## SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER

The highway running from Princess Alley 7 metres from its junction with Princess Street at the point marked A on the Plan in an easterly and then northerly direction for a distance of 97 metres to a point marked B on the Plan which is 6 metres south of its junction with Berry Street.
