**THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (MOSELEY OLD HALL LANE,
WOLVERHAMPTON) GATING ORDER 2014**

This Order is made by Wolverhampton City Council ("the Council") under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Council that Moseley Old Hall Lane, Wolverhampton is affected by anti-social behaviour the existence of the highway described below is facilitating the persistent commission of anti-social behaviour and it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purpose of reducing anti-social behaviour.

BY THIS ORDER:

1. The public right of way over the highway shown on the plan attached ("the plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order ("the highway") will be restricted during the hours of 6.00pm to 8.30am by installing an electronic gate across the highway at the location marked on the plan ("the gate").
2. The electronic gate mechanism will allow the gate to be opened using a remote key fob, a keypad next to the gate or a manual override switch. Mobile phones can also be programmed to operate the gate remotely. Residents of the Lane and those requiring access, including the emergency services, highway maintenance contractors employed by Wolverhampton City Council, Officers from Staffordshire County Council and statutory undertakers, will be provided, by the National Trust, with the necessary means to open and close the gate.
3. The maintenance of the gate will be the responsibility of the National Trust.

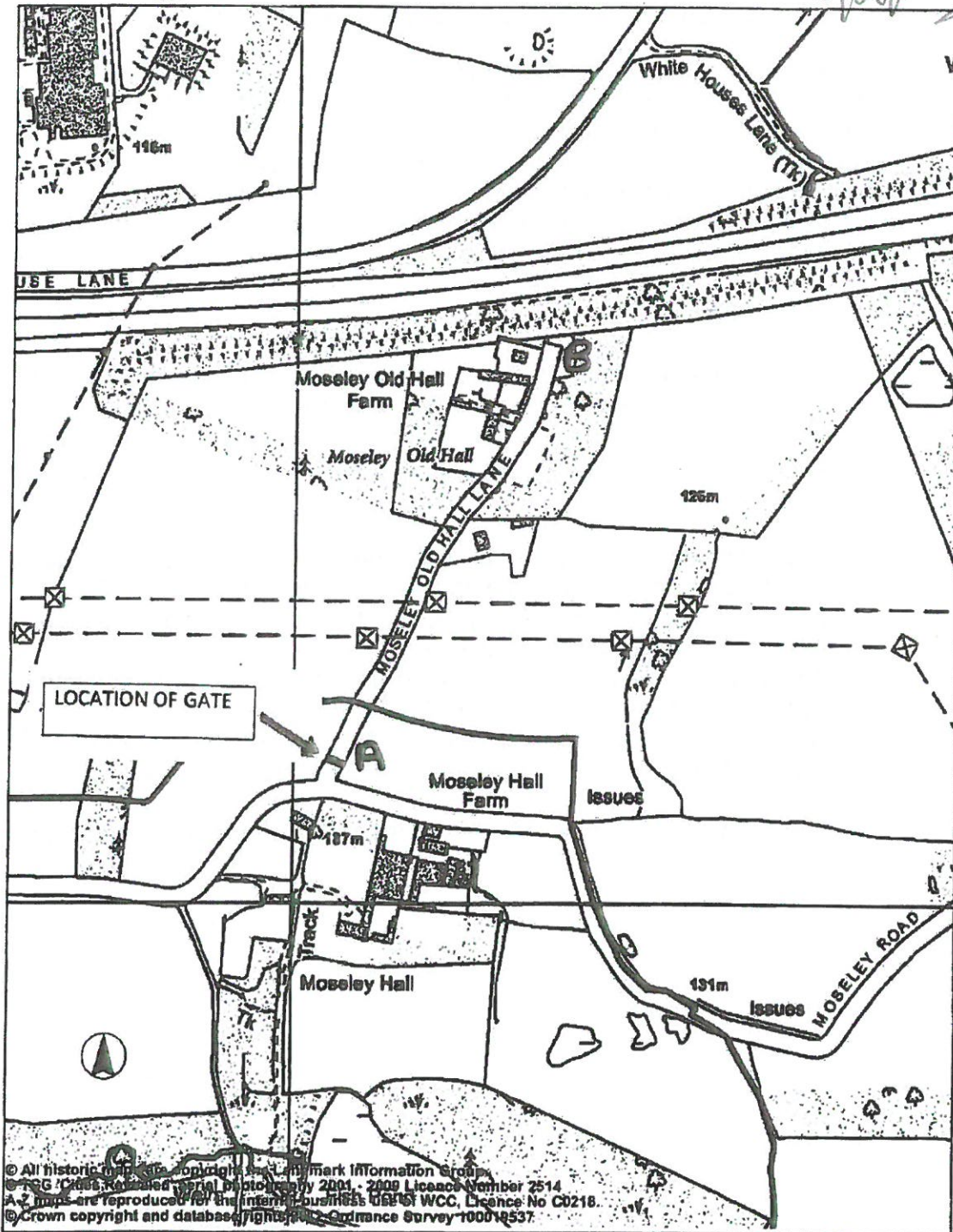

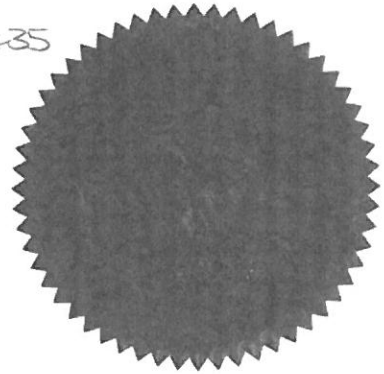
SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER
