
WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

THE WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL (BRICKHEATH ROAD, WOLVERHAMPTON) GATING ORDER 2010

This Order is made by Wolverhampton City Council ("the Council") under Section 129A of the Highways Act 1980 because it appears to the Council that Brickheath Road, Wolverhampton is affected by crime and anti-social behaviour the existence of the highway described below is facilitating the persistent commission of crime and anti-social behaviour and it is in all the circumstances expedient to make this Order for the purpose of reducing crime and anti-social behaviour.

BY THIS ORDER:

- 1. The public right of way over the highway shown on the plan attached ("the plan") and described in the Schedule to this Order ("the highway") will be restricted during the hours of 6.00pm to 6.30am by the erection of bollards across the highway at the location marked on the plan ("the bollards").
- Access to the highway will be permitted by the provision of keys to remove or lower the bollards to the occupiers of the New Cross Industrial Estate, the sub-station, vehicles for the purpose of maintaining the park accessed from Brickheath Road and the Emergency Services.
- 3. The maintenance of the bollards will be the responsibility of the Transportation Division of the Council at Heantun House, Salop Street, Wolverhampton with Mr Gwyn James being the point of contact on telephone number 01902 555755.



SCHEDULE TO THE ORDER

THE ROAD

The highway running from a point off Old Heath Road at the point marked A on the Plan attached ("the Plan") continuing in a easterly direction for a distance of 145 metres to the point marked B on the plan and then continuing in a northerly direction for a distance of 80 metres to the point marked C on the Plan.
