Construction of Residential Dwellings

Request:

I'm currently in the process of compiling local authority lists of address where non-traditional methods have been used in the construction of residential dwellings that were constructed by local authorities. Could you possibly provide any details you hold in regard to the type of property by system name, the address and if they have been subject to repair as a result of the Housing Act? If only partial information is available it will still be of great use.

Several mass building projects for local authority houses were constructed using prefabricated or in-situ techniques such as concrete or steel and often had trade names such as Reema, Wates, Cornish, BISF etc. These are both pre and post war. Some of these types were subject to further investigation under the Housing Act 1985.

If you have the road name and type (as above) this will be sufficient.
