Land for Public Purpose

Request:

Is any land within the WOLVERHAMPTON CITY COUNCIL area of authority required for public purpose i.e. land that is protected from development in the interests of future needs of the government, council, or statutory undertaker? If there is, please advise the location of the land and under what mechanism it is protected.

With reference to your above request, I can confirm that City of Wolverhampton Council holds this information. The information you have requested is exempt under Section 21 of the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA), because the information is accessible to you, as it is already in the public domain.

The adopted Wolverhampton Local Plan details all land in the City which is protected from certain types of development for various reasons, including Green Belt land, protected nature conservation areas and public open space.
