## Land on the Corner of Woden Road and Cannock Road

## **Request:**

It is my understanding that the land on the corner of Woden Road and Cannock Road (adjacent to No 1 Woden Road Wolverhampton WV10 0AU) belonged to Wolverhampton Council who subsequently sold it recently. I would therefore like to request any information regarding the maintenance of this land along with any plans regarding landscaping or highways.

In response to your above question, the land on the corner of Woden Road and Cannock Road (adjacent to No 1 Woden Road Wolverhampton WV10 0AU) was sold on 2 December 2016 and is no longer in City of Wolverhampton Council ownership. When in Council ownership, Environmental Services undertook some maintenance (chemical control) at this land, at the request of the land holding department. As the Council is no longer responsible for the maintenance of this land we are unable to supply any plans regarding landscaping or highways.

With reference to any planning applications that are in place we can confirm that the department holds information that you have asked for in relation to the above. However, the information is exempt under section 21 of the FOI Act because it is reasonably accessible to you, and I am pleased to inform you that the application number is 15/01429/FUL which you can access on our website via the following link: <a href="http://www.wolverhampton.gov.uk/planningapplications">http://www.wolverhampton.gov.uk/planningapplications</a>
