## Fly-tipping

## Request:

Under the Freedom of Information Act can you provide me with the following information:

- 1) How many incidents of fly-tipping were reported to the council in: a) the year:

  - c) 2017/2018? = 2,616
- 2) How much did the council spend on clearing up fly-tipping in the area in:
  - a) 2015/2016?
  - b) 2016/2017?
  - c) 2017/2018?

The cost of fly tip removal is incorporated in the Street Cleansing Budget. These costs are not identified separately.

- 3) How many people were successfully prosecuted for fly-tipping in: a) 2015/2016? b) 2016/2017? c) 2017/2018?
  - a) 2015/2016? 5
  - b) 2016/2017? 8
  - c) 2017/2018? 4
- 4) What were the ten highest streets in your locality for fly tipping? I am after the number of times your council has been called or has dealt with fly tipping in a street.
