## Bus Lane - Fines

## Request:

I would like to request the following information under the Freedom of Information act:
In response to your request, it should be noted that the figures provided in response to the following questions are actual numbers of Penalty Charge Notices (PCN) created and transferred onto the legal system. However, many PCN's will not be viable for various reasons and as such payment will not be due. Some examples for why a PCN may not proceed through to the payment stage is:

- DVLA do not hold driver information
- Cloned vehicle
- Driver absconded
- Driver or vehicle exempt from the Bus Lane charge.
- Successful outcome to a representation or appeal
- Enforcement Agent unable to recover value due to insufficient value of goods.
- Enforcement Agents unable to trace the driver

Therefore please note the numbers reported are the value of fines issued.
