## Adult Residential care

## Request:

- 1. How common is each of the following methods of procuring adult residential care? If the proportion is not held, instead please indicate how prominent each method of procuring care is, by ranking the following options (1 = most common method; 3 = least common method).
  - a. Block purchase 2
  - b. Spot purchase under framework agreement 3
  - Spot purchase without framework agreement 1
