School Buildings

Request:

1. How many school buildings in the authority, are known to the council as having asbestos? 69 schools in the Wolverhampton City Council area fall into this category. To put this into context, most buildings of a certain age contain asbestos in some shape or form, and Wolverhampton's schools are no different. The presence of asbestos in buildings is not in itself a risk to health, as long as the asbestos is either not damaged or located somewhere where it could easily be damaged.

In addition, the council will remove asbestos from school buildings as and when required.
