Request:

The Kennel Club is the largest organisation in the UK devoted to dog health, welfare and training. Its objective is to ensure that dogs live healthy, happy lives with responsible owners. As an organisation closely associated with dog breeding, the Kennel Club is intending to carry out research to gain insight into breeders licensed by local authorities. We are therefore contacting you alongside all local authorities in England and Wales to gather important data on a range of information regarding this issue.

 - (a) kept by him at any premises during any period of 12 months;
 - (b) kept by any relative of his at those premises;
 - (c) kept by him elsewhere; and
 - (d) kept by any person under a breeding arrangement with him
