## Request:

- 1. The numbers of school applications for each school *(primary and secondary)* under coordinated arrangements in 2013, 2014 and this year.
- 2. The published admission number for each of the schools *primary and* secondary included in the coordinated arrangements in 2013, 2014 and this year.
- 3. The numbers of admission appeals lodged, heard and upheld for each school in each of the years 2013, 2014 and this year.

### Response:

We can confirm that the department holds information that you have asked for however information on 2015 appeals is not available yet as we are currently in the appeals season.
