## Request:

Could you please provide me with a copy of your Contaminated Land Register?

## Response:

Wolverhampton City Council is required under Section 78R of Part IIA of the Environmental Protection Act 1990 to maintain a Public Register of Contaminated Land that holds certain prescribed information.

Following careful consideration, the information you requested falls under the exception(s) to disclosure contained in Regulation 6(1) (b) of the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 ("EIR"), which applies when the information is already publicly available and easily accessible to the applicant in another form or format.

The information is publicly available for public inspection, FREE of charge at: Regulatory Services, Civic Centre, St Peter's Square, Wolverhampton, WV1 1DA, during normal office hours, Mon-Thurs, (08:30–17:00) and Friday, (08:30–16:30).

It would be helpful if an appointment is made to ensure our staff can make the register available to view promptly.
