1) How much money has the city council spent on the Bilston Urban Village scheme to date and how much has it decided to spend on the project in future? Please provide a breakdown and brief description of what any spent money has covered such as: consultancy, clearance costs, demolition, remediation work, landscaping and the firms with which the city council spent this money, if known.

2) How much has the Homes and Communities Agency committed to the scheme? The Council has made available £2.5 million for the main Urban Village site which has been matched by an equivalent amount from the HCA.

How much the Homes and Communities Agency already spent on the scheme? Again please provide a breakdown if applicable and brief descriptions Following reasonable enquiries, it has been established that the Council does not hold the above information. Consequently, we are unable to provide any information relating to the above, as per Section 1(1)(a) of the Act:

3) How much private money has been committed to the Bilston Urban Village scheme? Where has it come from - please name the sources? How much of it is money from Section 106 agreements and if any of it has come from S.106 money, from which developments? How much of this money has come from community infrastructure levy and if this applies, from which developments? At the present time no private money has been committed to the Bilston Urban Village scheme.

The first private investment attracted to the Bilston Urban Village site will be through the development of residential plots F and N. The signing of the Development Agreement with Kier, which is due to take place within the next few weeks, will commit the company to a multi-million pound investment on the site in the region of \pounds 7- \pounds 8 million.
