Circuses

Request:

Please could you let me know whether your council allows circuses with animals to use council-owned land for performances? We have not, to date allowed any.

If not, can you confirm whether any ban on the use of council land is applied to circuses with all animal species or specific animal species (e.g. wild animals)? Our Animal Welfare Charter would restrict all animals in circuses.

Finally, can you confirm the date that any ban was implemented? Animal Welfare Charter was implemented in March 2007 [originally the charter was implemented in 1986]. The third revision develops further the commitment of the Council to animal welfare and takes account of the Animal welfare Act 2006. Additionally, the charter states:

The council will only allow circuses that include performing animals on council owned or managed land where:

- The circus must be open to inspection by the RSPCA and/or a vet nary surgeon appointed by the council at any time.
- The circus is a member of the Circus Proprietors Association.

The Council will use its powers to prevent inappropriate performing animal acts in theatres whenever possible.
